Corbel Block(s) - Timber blocks placed in horizontal orientation intended to distribute the load to adjacent rows of piles or other substructure components.

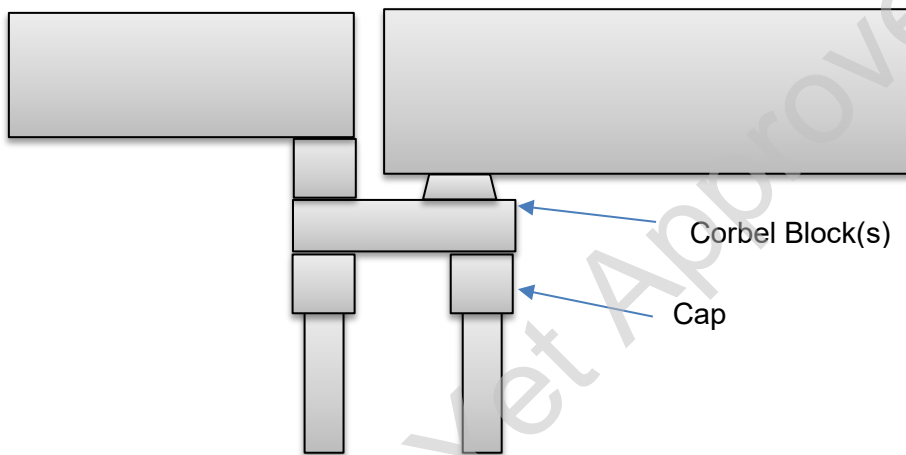


Figure 7-G-1. Example of Corbel Block

Modify article 4.5.1.e to read:

4.5.1.e. Where piling are decayed at the top, they may be cut off and double capped or **posted**. Single pile ~~shims~~ **corbels** may be considered.
